COOKIE POLICY

The AVIRE website and HUB platform use cookies to distinguish you from other users. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site. By continuing to use the site and HUB, you are agreeing to our use of cookies. A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree.

We use the following cookies:

- **Strictly necessary cookies.** These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our website, use a shopping cart or make use of e-billing services.
- **Analytical / performance cookies.** They allow us to recognize and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are find what they are looking for easily.
- **Functionality cookies.** These are used to recognize you when you return to our website. This enables us to personalize our content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region).
- **Targeting cookies.** These cookies record your visit to our website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. We will use this information to make our website and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests. We may also share this information with third parties for this purpose.

You can block cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of our site. Except for essential cookies, all cookies will expire after 12 months.

AWSALBCORS	STRICTLY NECESSARY	AWSALBCORS is a cookie provided by Amazon Web Services (AWS). It helps us ensure that your requests to our website are properly routed and that your session remains consistent, especially when you interact with features that require session continuity.	
AWSALB	STRICTLY NECESSARY	AWSALB is another cookie provided by Amazon Web Services (AWS). It plays a role in load balancing and session management, ensuring that your experience on our website is smooth and responsive.	
csrfToken	STRICTLY NECESSARY	csrfToken is used to protect against cross-site request forgery attacks.	
access_token	STRICTLY NECESSARY	access_token enables the user to access the application resources. It is the main user authentication cookie. Its expiration time is relatively short.	
refresh_token	STRICTLY NECESSARY	refresh_token cookie is used to renew the access_token cookie. This cookie does not provide access to any application resources. Its expiration time determines the user session time.	
allowCookies	STRICTLY NECESSARY	allowCookies sets a flag allowing other cookies to be present.	
_ga	NOT NECESSARY	Used to distinguish users.	The default expiration time is 2 years.
ga<container-id>	NOT NECESSARY	Used to persist session state.	The default expiration time is 2 years.
